Archery, knot tying, compass skills, shelter building, and much more!

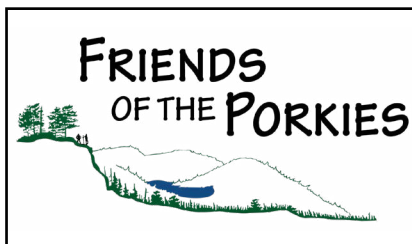
